Reflection on Last Sunday's Sermon >> >> Preacher: Sis. Andrea Toussaint

Title: Pursue Your Spiritual Blessing >>>>> Text: Ephesians 1:3-9

Introduction: What are you looking forward to or expecting for Christmas? There is something better or greater that we should seek after- pursue spiritual blessings. Blessing is the translation of the Greek word eulogy which means to speak well of. Blessing means that God has spoken good things about us or has pronounced good things for our benefit. Verse 3 of the passage speaks to Christians being blessed with every spiritual blessing. Three observations can be noted:

1. The Source of our Spiritual Blessing: The source of our spiritual blessing is identified in the passage as God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Sometimes, people attribute the source of their success to themselves; or to others: It is good to acknowledge these sources, however, there is a greater source, who is God.

Our God is the *creator*, of the universe, who made the environment with plants, animals and people. At the end of creation.

Our God is our **sustainer**, who made provisions for our needs including our physical, social and spiritual needs.

Our God is our **selector**, who according to verse 4, `chose us in Him before the creation of the world.`

2. The Substance of our Spiritual Blessing: The blessing referred to in the passage is spiritual in nature, encapsulated in the love of Christ. The substance of the blessing includes:

Redemption through His blood (v.7). Redemption means to *buy back*. God who created us, had to buy us back from sin, with the blood of Jesus as the price.

Forgiveness of sins (v.7). This means that regardless of what we have done, God can forgives us, of not some but all our sins.

 ${\it Grace}$ (v.6) Grace is favour which we do not deserve. God has redeemed and forgiven us because of his grace which he has lavished on us. We can therefore extend this grace to people who have hurt us.

Wisdom and understanding (v.8). God gives special insight to deal with some situations. Situations in which we cannot explain our actions but we know we were led by God. **Sonship** (v.5) Sonship signifies close relationship which gives us access to approach God without an appointment and status which gives us privileges in Christ.

3. The Signs of our Spiritual Blessing: Signs are manifestations of what is happening on the inside. There are also signs associated with spiritual blessings which include: **Worship** (v.3) When we think of the blessings of God, we cannot but worship because we recognize the source of our blessings.

Holiness (v.5) To be holy means to be set apart. God expects that having benefitted from his spiritual blessings, we would respond by living lives which are holy and acceptable to Him*(1 Corinthians 6:20) Holiness influences what we think, do and say.

Blamelessness (v.5) To be blameless does not mean that as Christian we are perfect but we are continually becoming blameless once we confess our sin and seek God's forgiveness.

We tend to pray for material blessings, however, let us pursue, spiritual blessing. They are more lasting and fulfilling. Let us remember the source and the substance of spiritual blessings and seek to demonstrate the signs of worship, holiness and blamelessness.
