Reflection on Last Sunday's Sermon > Preacher: Dea. Courtney Christie-Veitch **Title:** You are God's Masterpiece >>>> **Text:** Ephesians 2: 1-10 (NKJV)

We are His Workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them (v:10).

The preacher suggested that when Paul wrote this letter to the people of Ephesus, he Paul attempted to persuade the Ephesians that they should put their faith, not in man, not in material things, but that they should put their faith in the hands of God. The passage speaks to God sending His Son- Christ Jesus to save us. Even when we are dead in sin and our trespasses, for those who believe, will be made alive.

#### We Are God's Masterpiece

The message made these main observations...We are God' Masterpiece, created in His Image and likeness. And because by grace we have been saved through faith, we are God's workmanship, and we are here to find the purpose that God has for our lives; because of this, first, we are to take care of ourselves, do things for ourselves. The preacher stated that we should not make everything about "work, work, work"; we should take time for ourselves and spend time with God.

Even when we find ourselves in deep waters and trials, always remember that we are God's workmanship. Let no one tell us otherwise...as we are fearfully and wonderfully made.

### We Are God's Mouthpiece

And because we are His workmanship, we have to be God's Mouthpiece as well. We have to tell others of the goodness of God; show and tell; be deliberate about it. We can witness to friends and family, and share the Word about the goodness & greatness of God. Give spiritual guidance to our family and friends. When last have we told someone that God is good. Encourage others especially the youth; by the Brotherhood mentoring them. Model our lives so that persons can see that we are God's mouthpiece. If we want to reach persons, we have to go where they are. Be God's mouthpiece at the workplace, in the community, wherever they are.

## Finding God's Purpose

There is purpose in whatever we do and being what God wants us to be, and doing what He has planned for us. We have to find the work that God has planned for us, according to the Scriptures. In finding purpose, we need to be aligned to the work that God has planned for us; find your space and purpose. God has a unique work/purpose for each and every one to walk into. All we have to do is to be obedient, hear and listen to His Voice, and walk into God's plan and purpose for your life. However, we can't do it by ourselves, we need others.
