Reflection on Last Sunday's Sermon >>> Preacher: Rev. Dr. Dylan Toussaint

Title: Don't Take the Fake >>>>> **Text:** St. Luke 7:11-23

"Authentic" is the word of the year for 2023 according to Merriam-Webster Dictionary. The Dictionary noted that authentic has a number of meanings including "not false or imitation," a synonym of real and actual; and also "true to one's own personality, spirit, or character."

There is an authentication crisis in the world today- a crisis in determining the genuine versus, the fake.

December 3, 2023 represents the first Sunday in Advent. Advent focuses on the return of Jesus Christ.

In the passage, John the Baptist ("John") heard of the miracles Jesus had done and curiously sent his disciples to ask Jesus:

- 1. Whether He was the one; or
- 2. Whether they should expect someone else.

John did not want a fake Messiah. He wanted the real deal.

Giving guidance from the passage on how to treat with information received, the preacher used **FAKE** as an acronym as follows:

1. Facts

Get the facts. John sent his disciples directly to Jesus to inquire about Jesus' authenticity. Get the facts so you do not jump to conclusions or make false assumptions.

2. Assessment

Make an assessment. Notably, Jesus did not directly answer John's question. Jesus responded to John's question by performing miracles and instructing John's disciples to tell John the miracles they had seen and heard.

Jesus' verbal response was a direct quote from the book of Isaiah, as Isaiah had prophesied centuries before of what to look for in the Messiah. Isaiah gave the blueprint or the criteria. Jesus essentially told John to make the assessment.

3. Know

Knowing the genuine makes it easier to identify the fake.

Galatians 5:22-23 gives us the blueprint to assess our lives as Christians- the fruit of the spirit. Matthew 7:20 reminds us that by their fruit you shall know them. The blueprint is the life people live. Assess the fruit.

Know your limitations. John and Jesus were familiar with each other. John and Jesus were cousins. John baptized Jesus. John declared prepare ye the way of the Lord.

John knew his limitations and in this passage, sought confirmation. If John knew his limitation and asked Jesus for confirmation, what about us?

4. Expand

Expand or enlarge your focus on the Lord. Luke 7:23 states that "blessed is He, whosoever shall not be offended in Me". Jesus intimated that John should focus on Him.

Your relationship with God is what is most important. Doubts will always come. Remain focused.
